PENNDOT: PIPE REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN LONDONDERRY TOWNDSHIP TO CONTINUE

A PennDOT maintenance crew in Dauphin County is scheduled to begin the second phase of a two-phase pipe replacement project on Hillsdale Road (Route 2001) between Foxianna Road and Sawmill Road in Londonderry Township.

This phase of the project, which is expected to begin August 3 and be completed by September 4, includes work from South Geyers Road to Sawmill Road, according to a press release.

Hillsdale Road will be closed to thru traffic weekdays between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., weather permitting, while sections of the roadway are excavated, the existing corroded corrugated metal pipes are removed, corrugated plastic pipes are installed, inlet boxes are reconstructed, and the roadway is reestablished. A detour will use Covered Bridge Road, Pecks Road, River Road (Route 441) and South Geyers Road, the release said.

The first phase of the project, which included work between Foxianna Road and South Geyers Road, began in mid-July and wraps up before the start of the second phase.
