

OVERVIEW:

- Rounds of strong to severe thunderstorms probable today
- Primary threat: Damaging wind gusts (60+ mph)
- Hail and locally heavy rainfall/isolated flooding also possible

TIMING & LOCATION

- First cluster of storms moving across north-central PA 9AM-3PM
- Second round of storms likely between 3-11PM from I-80 south to the Maryland border


HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Damaging winds are the primary hazard followed by hail and locally heavy rainfall; tornado risk is low but non-zero
- T-storm impacts may include downed trees and wires, structural/property damage, and isolated power outages

FORECAST CHALLENGES Confidence has increased for timing, location and intensity with a corridor of damaging winds likely. This corresponds to an increase in the severe thunderstorm risk level from 2 to 3 out of 5.
