## **Citizens Input**

# Manager's Report – Steve Letavic

### **Tree Harvest at Sunset Golf Course**

The trees will be marked in 30 days, harvest is planned for the fall and restoration for the fall/spring (depending on weather).

# Stage

The stage at Sunset Bar & Grill is complete. This project was funded with a grant, no tax dollars were used.

#### **Performance Appraisals**

Mr. Letavic informed the board that they are half way through the performance appraisals and should be complete by early June and to the board for review.

### **Solar Projects**

Mr. Letavic reported that he is looking into a solar project that would provide power for Public Works & Golf Course Maintenance buildings, 50 year life span with no out of pocket expense to the township.

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# **Clubhouse Walls/Deck Expansion**

Mr. Letavic is waiting on an opinion of cost, if grant funding is available they will move forward with the projects.

#### Suez

Mr. Letavic reported that the Middletown Sewer System is hoping to sewer the Rte. 230 corridor but it is currently being held up. Mr. Stewart explained that Middletown has the desire to sewer the corridor, but the exact service the structure will take remains uncertain due to changing dynamics in Middletown.

#### **Water Line Extension**

Mr. Letavic stated that they are working with HRG to bring a 16" water line down to Swatara Creek Road and Iron Mine Road. He believes this will be completed this year.

# National Fish & Wildlife (Lynch Run)

There will be a pre-bid meeting on May 6th in regards to preventing the bank erosion of Lynch Run along Hertzler Road. This project is expected to be completed this summer.

# Zoning & Codes Report – Jeff Burkhart Landscape Buffer Deferral Request – Matincheck Assoc., Inc., 2912 River Road

Supervisor Kopp motioned to approve the request to defer planting of a portion of the landscape buffer shown on the approved land development plan per the attached letter from Burget & Associates, Inc., Supervisor Hershey seconded. Motion approved.

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# License Transfer - Luttrell's Auto Salvage, 4207 Roush Road

Mr. Burkhart informed the board that he and Ms. Funk performed the annual inspection of the salvage yard earlier this year and found no issues.

Supervisor Kopp motioned to authorize the transfer of the license to operate the salvage (junk) yard from Luttrell's Auto Salvage to Graybill Auto Repair & Salvage, LLC., Supervisor Hershey seconded. Motion approved.

# MS4 Environmental Report - Allison Funk, Amanda Kopil DEP MS4 Audit Update

Ms. Funk informed the board that the March 10<sup>th</sup> DEP Audit went well. The auditors visited the Public Works and Golf Course buildings and also Swatara Creek Road to see the tree planting. The report stated that Londonderry Township takes MS4 seriously and the MCM's are by far the best of those he has inspected so far. Supervisor Dale complimented the township for the progressive efforts. Mr. Kopp commented on the DEP Audit and the Inlet Markers, asked about the Swatara Creek maintenance buffer growing period.

## **Workshops Scheduled**

Ms. Funk announced that the MS4 Department will hold a Rain Barrel Workshop on Saturday, July 16<sup>th</sup> at 10am and a Composting Workshop on Saturday, August 20<sup>th</sup> at 10am. Ms. Funk informed the board that the Cub Scouts will be planting approximately 40 trees along Swatara Creek Road on May 22<sup>nd</sup> at 10am.

Mrs. Graham informed the board that Summer Playground is scheduled to begin June 13<sup>th</sup> and run through July 29<sup>th</sup>, with 1 leader returning and 2 that need to be hired.

#### **Public Works Report** – Andy Brandt

Mr. Brandt reported on the work accomplished for April and the work intended to be completed in May which include paving repairs on potholes, cleaning gutters, replace damaged street signs, replace storm sewer pipe on S. Geyers Church Road and Brinser Road (permits pending), truck and equipment maintenance as needed.

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Mr. Johnson reported that the total revenue for April through the 19<sup>th</sup> was \$59,161.00. For the month of May:

- 16 golf outings scheduled

For the season to date:

- 97 golf outings booked
- Clubhouse rented 21 times

Mr. Johnson also informed the board that they continue to send out flyers regarding outings, rentals, memberships and tee sponsorships as well as grill specials. He also reported that the stage was almost finished and the Thursday Night Live Music Series begins May 5<sup>th</sup> with Jeffery J. Walker.
